PROGRAMS & PROJECTS*

- Art & Photography Exhibitions: *April 4 – 21, 2008* Over 200 works by area artists at the Emporium and Three Flights Up Gallery on Gay Street
- Art In Public Places Knoxville: *April – June 2008* 25 – 40 large scale sculptures to be installed in downtown for 90 + days
- A Very Special Arts Festival: *April 23, 2008 at West HS* 27th year of creating an arts festival experience for over 400 Knox Co. school children with diverse needs
- Cardboard Boat Regatta: *April 20, 2008* Art and design come together as boats (cardboard, duct tape and paint, only) launched and raced on area waterways (tbd)
- Diva Luncheon: *April 16, 2008* “We’ve Got a Shoe Attitude!” Featuring food, entertainment and a gathering of the powers that be, as well as a small juried show of art by area women artists and women produced products
- Festival on Market Square: *April 11 – 13, 2008* Art in the Park technique demonstrations in several mediums, Walk, Blue Grass Blowout with local and regional performers, arts projects for kids, artists marketplace, music and dance, and special projects (vary year-to-year)
- House & Garden Show *February 22 – 24* at the Knoxville Convention Center, this is the main fundraising event for the Festival held in February, presents commercial exhibitors as well as design projects incorporating past Dogwood prints, and interiors
- Jazz Concert: *April 8, 2008* at the Bijou Theater, presented in conjunction with the Knoxville Jazz Orchestra (2008 is a Tribute to Ella Fitzgerald featuring vocalist Deborah Brown)
- Knox Co. Art Teachers “Art Source” the 10th year for the exhibit at the Phoenix Building, the Annual Exhibition exhibition dates are *October 22 – November 16, 2007*
- Limited Edition Print: Selected work by local artist for annual print edition, selected by public vote. An all entry exhibition at the Three Flights Up Gallery *February 1 – 17, 2008* to select finalists, and second vote for the winner is held at the House & Garden Show, *February 22 – 24, 2008*
- Opening Ceremonies
 Trails Opening *April 9, 2008* The Dogwood Trails — where it all started. Over seventy miles of beautiful trails through seven of Knoxville’s most beautiful and architecturally significant neighborhoods. The anchor and inspiration of all things Dogwood. 2008 Featured Trail is Sequoyah Hills
- Open Gardens *April 4 – 23, 2008* Continues the inclusion of the natural beauty of the region in public and private gardens, garden by-ways and camera stops
- Parade *Friday evening, April 11, 2008* “Let the Bloomtimes Roll” — the parade features the Knox County High School Marching Bands and Music Programs along with community entries designed and executed to theme
